The colorant, combined with a polymer surfactant blend, has a unique visco-elastic effect on very small aerosol droplets in the spray. By decreasing the number of these droplets, spray drift and the risk of non-target applications is reduced.

2DYE4 BLUE is a unique water soluble spray colorant for use with herbicides, fungicides, insecticides, grass growth retardants, wetting agents and liquid fertilizers.
